Marcel Dekker Statius' Achilleid is perhaps the most remarkable of all Latin epic poems. Its project - to tell the whole life of Achilles - was cut short by the poet's untimely death. attempt to save her son from his destined end in the Trojan war, hid him on the island of Scyros, disguised as a girl. These themes are explored in a new introduction by Robert Cowan, which surveys the latest research on the poem.
