Son of a famous father. Father of a

famous son. I am the hyphen between them. Only, Rishi Kapoor was and is so much more. Few actors in Hindi cinema have had this sort of a career arc: from the gawky adolescent pining for his schoolteacher (*Mera Naam Joker*, 1970) to the naughty ninety-year-old (*Kapoor & Sons*, 2016), Rishi Kapoor has regaled audiences for close to fifty years.
