Banned in India by the British colonial government, The Indian Struggle was published in the country only in 1948

after India became independent. The book analyses a period of the Indian independence struggle from the Non-Cooperation and Khilafat Movements of the early 1920s to the Quit India and Azad Hind movements of the early 1940s. The first part of *The Indian Struggle* covering the years 1920-1934 was published in London in 1935 by Lawrence and Wishart. Subhas Chandra Bose's exile in Burmese prisons from 1924 to 1927 witnessed the transformation of a lieutenant into a leader. During the non-cooperation movement and its aftermath he had wholeheartedly accepted Deshbandhu Chitta Ranjan Das as his political mentor. The apprenticeship was cut short by Deshbandhu's death in June 1925. When Subhas received this terrible news as a prisoner in Mandalay, he felt desolate with a sense of bereavement, as he wrote to his friend Dilip Kumar Roy. There is a number of problems connected with the study and teaching of any Oriental literature in general and of Tamil literature specifically which have to date been mostly ignored, although they are indispensable for solid knowledge and correct interpretation and understanding of the literature in question. These include problems of authenticity and authorship, of transmission and tradition, writing tools and materials, of relationship of orality to literacy, of Sanskrit to Tamil, the prehistory of Tamil written literature, the numerous texts that have been lost,
