Sámi Educational History in a Comparative International Perspective El Colegio de San Luis

This book is a reference grammar of Kulina, an Amazonian language spoken in Brazil and Peru. The dialect described by the author is spoken on the upper Purus River in the Brazilian state of Acre. Kulina belongs to the Arawan language family. It is predominantly head-marking and has a complex verbal morphology which is largely agglutinating with some instances of fusion. The language has

two noun classes and two genders. The gender agreement of transitive verbs with their arguments is in part governed by intricate grammatical rules and in part pragmatically driven. There are three types of possession, alienable, inalienable, and kinship. The latter category only applies to some kinship nouns, while others are alienably possessed. Kulina has aspirated and unaspirated obstruents, but different aspirated obstruents do not co-occur in one morpheme due to Grassmann's law, a dissimilation process known from Sanskrit and Ancient Greek. The book contains two Kulina texts and a chapter on the lexicon, which discusses colour terms, generic nouns for plants and animals, pet vocatives, idioms, and the origin of loan words.

El estudio de las artes en la Universidad de Buenos Aires lleva más de cien años de historia. Al principio, en los comienzos del siglo XX, se introdujo como materia suelta en las carreras de Letras, Historia y Filosofía. En 1924 se creó el Gabinete de Historia del Arte, que en 1940 se convertiría en Instituto.

En 1963 se creó la carrera de Historia de las Artes (hoy llamada Artes), con Julio Payró como primer director. Este estudio propone un recorrido histórico por la disciplina, que aborda sus diferentes líneas de enseñanza, sus cambios curriculares y las trayectorias de sus profesores más destacados, así como los cambios de paradigma y los nuevos desafíos a los que se enfrenta en la actualidad.

Unlike other regions around the world, several Latin American countries have managed to reduce income inequality over the last decade. Higher growth rates and growing employment, but also

innovative wage policies and social programs, have contributed to reducing poverty and narrow income disparities. Grammars in Contact Fundación la Salle de Cienc E Antropología y Sociología El 23 de septiembre de 1604, llegó a Santafé la expedición fundadora de la Compañía de Jesús y el día 27 se hizo entrega de la real cédula a la Chancillería Real, mediante la que se autorizaba su fundación en la Nueva Granada. Pocos meses después, el primero de enero de 1605, se empezaron a impartir clases en el colegio de Santafé, que después se convertiría en el Colegio Máximo de la Provincia del Nuevo Reino de Granada y sería conocido como la Universidad Javeriana. A partir de ese momento, se dio inicio a una empresa intelectual, religiosa y social que persiste hasta hoy, cuyo recorrido ha estado marcado por los conflictos, la persecución y la

diáspora. Antes de la publicación del decreto de expulsión de los jesuitas en 1767, ordenado por Carlos III, e incluso después de la dispersión de sus miembros por todo el mundo, la orden de Ignacio de Loyola estuvo conformada por una base heterogénea de individuos que educaron y formaron a toda una élite intelectual en el territorio neogranadino. Así, aportaron ideas del Viejo Continente y animaron las discusiones académica y religiosa en el Nuevo Mundo. En un esfuerzo de sistematización, el padre José del Rey Fajardo, S. J., ha reunido en este nomenclátor información precisa sobre los miembros de la Compañía de Jesús que trabajaron en la Nueva Granada desde 1604 hasta 1767, y posteriormente en tierras italianas hasta

1831. Desde esta perspectiva, se podrá ver cómo esta orden religiosa se insertó en los prolegómenos de una historia intelectual de los jesuitas del Renacimiento y en la génesis neogranadina, y también cómo y por qué sus miembros han concurrido a la obra común que ayudó a engendrar la modernidad.

Maipure Universidad Los Andes Ethnoprimateology is situated at the intersection between the biological and cultural subfields of anthropology. Research on the interface between human and nonhuman primates has been steadily increasing since 1997, when the term ethnoprimateology was first coined. Although there have been studies on human-nonhuman primate interactions in the tropical Americas, no single comprehensive volume has been published that integrates this information to fully understand it in this region. Eighteen novel chapters written by outstanding scholars with various backgrounds are included in this edited volume. They refer to the complex interconnections between different

indigenous peoples with New World monkeys that sympatrically share their ancestral territories. Geographically, the range covers all of the Neotropics, from southern Mexico through northern Argentina. This work includes topics such as primates as prey and food, ethnozoology/ethnoecology, cosmology, narratives about monkeys, uses of primates, monkeys as pets, and ethnoclassification. Multiple views as well as diverse theoretical and methodological approaches are found within the pages. In sum, this is a compendium of ethnoprimateological research that will be prized by anthropologists, ethnobiologists, primatologists, conservationists, and zoologists alike. The Latin American centennial celebrations of independence (ca.1909-1925) constituted a key moment in the consolidation of national symbols and emblems, while also producing a renewed focus on transnational affinities that generated a series of discourses about continental unity. At the same time, a boom in archaeological explorations, within a general climate of scientific positivism provided Latin Americans with new information about their "grandiose" former civilizations, such as the Inca and the Aztec, which some argued were

comparable to ancient Greek and Egyptian cultures. These discourses were at first political, before transitioning to the cultural sphere. As a result, artists and particularly musicians began to move away from European techniques and themes, to produce a distinctive and self-consciously Latin American art. In *Inca Music Reimagined* author Vera Wolkowicz explores Inca discourses in particular as a source for the creation of "national" and "continental" art music during the first decades of the twentieth century, concentrating on operas by composers from Peru, Ecuador and Argentina. To understand this process, Wolkowicz analyzes early twentieth-century writings on Inca music and its origins and describes how certain composers

transposed "Inca" techniques into their own works, and how this music was perceived by local audiences. Ultimately, she argues that the turn to Inca culture and music in the hopes of constructing a sense of national unity could only

succeed within particular intellectual circles, and that the idea that the inspiration of the Inca could produce a "music of America" would remain utopian.
