Their roots lie in the
heavy rock of 70s groups
like Deep Purple. The
music they played—heavy
metal mixed with punk
attitude—became its own
genre: thrash. Their
bassist died and they
survived to become the
biggest-selling band in the
world. As grunge
threatened to overtake
them, they reinvented
