Gene Stratton-Porter's "Moths of the Limberlost" is a must-have for nature lovers all around the world because of her skillful explanations of moths and sharp observation about nature and life in general. Gene Stratton-Porter (1863 - 1924) was an American naturalist, photographer, and author. She is well known for being one of the first ever women to start a movie production company. While residing in Geneva, Stratton-Porter spent much time exploring, observing nature, sketching, and making photographs at the Limberlost Swamp. She also began writing stories and books about nature; Moths of the Limberlost was of them. The Limberlost swamp was the setting for two of her most popular novels, *Freckles* (1904) and *A Girl of the Limberlost* (1909).
