Patients in coma, vegetative state/unresponsive wakefulness syndrome, and in minimally
 conscious states pose medical, scientific, and ethical challenges. As patients with disorders of
 consciousness are by definition unable to communicate, the assessment of pain, quality of life, and
 end-of-life preferences in these conditions can only be approached by adopting a third-person

perspective. Surveys of healthcare workers' attitudes towards pain and end of life in disorders of consciousness shed light on the background of clinical reality, where no standard medical-legal framework is widely accepted. On the other hand, patients with locked-in syndrome, who are severely paralyzed but fully conscious, can inform about subjective quality of life in serious disability and help us to understand better the underlying factors influencing happiness in disease.
