The book is categorized as Children's Fiction because of its charming cover and talking stuffed animals but is inspirational to young and old alike, and a perfect antidote in these still troubled times; this is indeed a book for all.

The history of women and art in Canada has often been celebrated as a story of progress from amateur to professional

practice.
