Peter Forbes, an intelligent and likeable but somewhat innocent and naïve young man, is twenty-three years old when he arrives in tropical Africa to join a field survey party of the Topographic Surveys directorate in the late 1950s. The life of surveyors in the bush is arduous and his task is a physically demanding one. For the next nine months his work will take him through dense equatorial rainforest to high mountains and grassy plateaux over 12,000 feet above sea level. Left on his own with the locally recruited Africans employed as lorry drivers, cooks and labourers, Forbes has to develop his strong latent qualities to survive and overcome problems, usually on his own, far from help. Jack Parker is in charge, a man older and more experienced than Forbes. They are of very different personalities and he takes great pleasure in introducing the impressionable Forbes to the local communities and the lively social scene between the Europeans stationed in the area, leading to the unworldly young surveyor becoming involved in casual affairs with two assertive women. The contrast between the dedication of the relatively few Europeans in the bush, working for Africa, and the others who enjoy the benefits of status and high salaries in the more developed centres could not have been more pronounced. Nine months later, his first tour at an end, Forbes leaves Africa, and in that time he has grown up, learned about the practice of

surveying, and acquired a lasting love for the Dark Continent and its people.

Dive into this no-holds-barred group autobiography of the critically acclaimed feminist punk-rock group, The Lunachicks—featuring never-before-seen materials from the band's private archive. Fallopian Rhapsody: The Story of the Lunachicks is a coming-of-age tale about a band of NYC teenagers who forged a sisterhood, found salvation, and fervently crashed the gates of punk rock during the '90s, accidentally becoming feminist icons along the way. More than that, this is a

story about the enduring friendship among the book's three central voices: Theo Kogan, Sydney Silver, and Gina Volpe. They formed the Lunachicks at LaGuardia High School (of "Fame" fame) in the late '80s and had a record deal with Blast First Records as teenagers, whisked into the studio by Kim Gordon and Thurston Moore. Over the course of thirteen-ish years, the Lunachicks brought their brand of outrageous hard-rockin' rebelliousness around the world countless times, simultaneously scaring conservative onlookers and rescuing the souls of wayward freaks, queers, and outcasts. Their unforgettable costume-critiques of pop culture were as loud as their "Marsha[II]" amps, their ferocious tenacity as lasting as their pre-internet mythology. They toured with bands like the Go-Go's, Marilyn Manson, No Doubt, Rancid, and The Offspring; played the Reading Festival with Nirvana; and rocked the main stage at the Warped tour twice. Yet beneath all the makeup, wigs, and hilarious outfits were three women struggling to grow into adulthood under the most unorthodox of conditions. Together onstage they were invincible B-movie superheroes who kicked heaps of ass—but apart, not so much. Depression, addiction, and identity crises loomed overhead, not to mention the barrage of sexist nonsense they faced from the music industry. Filled with never-before-seen photos, illustrations, and ephemera from the band's private archive, and featuring contributions from Lunachicks drummer Chip English, founding member Sindi B., and former bandmate Becky Wreck, *Fallopian Rhapsody* is a bawdy,

gripping, warts-and-all account of how these city kids relied on their cosmic creative connection to overcome internal strife and external killjoys, all the while empowering legions of fans to shoot for the moon. For readers of Carrie Brownstein's *Hunger Makes Me a Modern Girl*, Kim Gordon's *Girl in a Band*, and Chrissie Hynde's *Reckless, Fallopian Rhapsody* is the literary equivalent of diving headfirst into a moshpit and slowly but surely venturing up to the front of the stage.

The *Flaming Cow* offers a rare insight into the brilliant but often fraught collaboration between Pink Floyd and composer Ron Geesin, the result of which became known as *Atom Heart Mother* – the Floyd's first UK number one album. From the time drummer Nick Mason visited Geesin's damp basement flat in Notting Hill, to the last game of golf between bassist Roger Waters and Geesin, this book is an unflinching account about how one of Pink Floyd's most celebrated compositions came to life. Alongside unpublished photographs from the Abbey Road recording sessions (the only ones taken) and the subsequent performances in London and Paris, Geesin goes on to describe how the title was chosen, why he was not credited on the record, how he left Hyde Park in tears, and why the group did not much like the work. The *Flaming Cow* rose again, firstly in France, then in London in 2008. After 40 years *Atom Heart Mother* remains a much-loved record, and *The Flaming Cow* explores its new-found cult status that has led to it being studied for the French Baccalauréat.

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
