The industry consumed 60 percent of the nation's synthetic rubber, and 46 percent of the lead. #3 The company declined under Henry II's father, Edsel, who was unable to walk away from his job. He was eventually killed by stomach cancer in 1943. #4 Henry II took over the failing Ford Motor Company in 1948, and he spent nearly \$100 million on the launch of the new car. It was a slinky Ford with a snub nose and enough interior room that a man could drive with his hat on.
