The car made "for the great multitude" (as Ford put it) first debuted in 1908 and proved so affordable and so popular that fifteen</p>
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million were sold through 1927. The "Tin Lizzie" was the first automobile to be mass-produced on moving assembly lines, and built using interchangeable parts. It proved tough and reliable in everyday use, and cheap enough to spawn the automobile revolution: the car cost \$850 in 1909 but amazingly by the 1920s, the price had dropped to a mere \$260 due to the perfection of production

techniques and economy of scale. Designed by a team that included Childe Harold Willis, Joseph Galamb and Eugene Farkas, the Model T had a front-mounted four-cylinder engine that produced 20 hp and had a top speed of 45 mph. It was a rear-wheel drive vehicle with wooden wheels, and featured a two-speed transmission plus a reverse gear. Although models varied - and many revisions took place over two

decades of production - the original version weighed about 1200 pounds.
