This is not a metaphor. The malady itself is very real. Whether we can regain our collective sanity as a society remains to be seen.

Nobody has ever studied the archives for similarities, traits and geographical clusters of missing people, until now. A tip from a national park ranger led to this three year, 7000+

The book chronicles children, adults and the elderly who disappeared, sometimes in the presence of friends and relatives. missing children that aren't on any national database \* Unusual behavior by bloodhounds/canines involved in the search process \* How storms, berries, swamps, briar patches, boulder fields and victim disabilities play a role in the disappearance \* The strategies of Search and Rescue personnel need to change under specific circumstances Major news organizations do a deplorable job of covering stories and issues which are deemed too unusual or too far outside the box.
