Following the popularity of this book, the author wrote a second volume, which also has a translated called *Bharat: Nehru Ke Baad*. Born and brought up in Dehradun, Gua, a graduate from Delhi University and IIM Calcutta has also taught at Yale, Stanford and University of California. Among the famous books that Gua has written are: *India after Gandhi*, *The States of Indian Cricket* and *This Fissured Land: An Ecological History of India*.
