The purpose of this mixed methods study was to identify and describe the body of occupational therapists, physical therapists, and speech-language pathologists and the therapy assistants from each profession who work in

neonatal intensive care units across the U.S.; the practice settings in which they work; their educational backgrounds and professional preparation to practice in the NICU; and their interest in pursuing neonatal therapy national certification. To date, there has never been a comprehensive study of neonatal therapy nor the therapy professionals working in this practice area in the United States (U.S.). Invitations to participate in this web-based survey were disseminated via email, social media, and direct contact through phone calls. The survey received 482 responses with therapists from 266 hospitals across all 50 states represented in the data. The outcomes of this study reveal that there is insufficient standardization in clinical training and preparedness for

therapy professionals practicing in the NICU, and variable adherence to the guidelines for education and training established by the governing national bodies of occupational therapy, physical therapy, and speech-language pathology professions. The results of this study indicate that moving forward with the creation of neonatal therapy national certification is a valid next step.

Continued research is needed to identify the specific knowledge, skills, abilities, practice responsibilities, critical tasks, risks, and practice context for the purpose of developing assessment measures, test blue prints, and examination questions in line with the creation of neonatal therapy national certification requirements.
