Included among the contributions are essays on existentialism in Daniel Clowes's graphic novel "Ghost World," ecocriticism in Paul Chadwick's long-running "Concrete" series, and political philosophies in Herge's perennially popular "The Adventures of Tintin." Maurice De Bevere, alias Morris (1923-2001), de man die in 1946 de legendarische stripfiguur Lucky Luke bedacht, was een van de productiefste auteurs uit het gouden tijdperk van de Franco-Belgische strip. De kunst van Morris biedt de lezer aan de hand van originele platen en illustraties van de auteur een nadere beschouwing van diens unieke stijl.
