Az ember a tudomány segítségével újratерemti a dinoszauruszokat... de vajon milyen az a világ, amely a géntechnológia játékszere? Alan Grant, a híres őslénykutató két másik tudós és egy ügyvéd kíséretében a Costa Rica nyugati partjához közeli Isla Nublar szigetre érkezik, hogy „elmondja véleményét” a különnc, gátlástalan multimilliomos, John Hammond új „szabadidőparkjáról” a közelgő nyitás előtt. A tét hatalmas: a hosszú évek megfeszített kutatómunkája és sok-sok millió dollár elköltése árán létrehozott parknak az első „vendégek” előtt jelesre kell vizsgáznia, ellenkező esetben a befektetőket képviselő ügyvéd leállítja az egész projektet. Hammondnak a világhírről, a boldogan mosolygó gyermeki arcocskákról és persze a gigantikus bevételekről szőtt álmai veszélybe kerülnek. A parkba érkezve a vendégek elképedve szembesülnek azzal, hogy Hammond megvalósította a

lehetetlent, és a Jurassic Park pontosan az, amit a neve sugall. Kezdetét veszi az első kalandtúra, és hamarosan kiderül, hogy hiába a sokszorosan túlbiztosított védelmi rendszer, a természet utat tör... A könyv olvasása igazi nyolc napon túl gyógyuló élményt nyújt – Michael Crichton oldalról oldalra építi fel a hihetlen történet fordulatait, s a cselekménybe szinte észrevétlenül simulnak bele az érthetővé tett tudományos ismeretek. Az Androméda-törzs, A gömb, Zaklatás, Jurassic Park... kivételes alkotások egy kivételes amerikai művész és tudós: MICHAEL CRICHTON író, forgatókönyvíró és filmrendező munkái közül. Michael Crichton (1942–2008) a kilencvenes évek egyik legnépszerűbb írója volt világszerte. Regényei az eladási listák élén tanyáztak, és a hollywoodi stúdiók sorban készítették ezekből a kasszasikereket a legnagyobb sztárok főszereplésével. 1994 decemberében munkái egyszerre vezették az USA-ban a mozis (Zaklatás) és a televíziós (Vészhelyzet 1. epizód) nézettségi és a könyveladási (Zaklatás) listákat. Regényei többségében a legújabb

és az olvasók számára legizgalmasabb tudományterületek (géntechnológia, mikroelektronika, kvantumfizika stb.) művelői a főszereplők, akik az adott tudományág (akkor még) ismeretlen határvidékeit kutatva kerülnek elképesztő, a képzeletet megindító kalandokba. Írásai közös jellemzője a tudományos ismeretek hiteles, tömör és közérthető beleszövése a cselekménybe: ezek bemutatása nem megakasztja a történetet, hanem előreviszi és újabb izgalmakat sejtet. Több műfajban is maradandót alkotott: techno-thriller (pl. Gyilkos nap), történelmi kalandregény (pl. Ködsárcányok), sci-fi (pl. Az Androméda-törzs), történelmi krimi (A nagy vonatrablás), technokaland (pl. Idővonal). Michael Crichton nemcsak íróként és filmrendezőként (pl. Kóma), hanem ismeretterjesztő tudósként is elismert személyiség volt, a tudományos kutatás, a tudomány iránt érzett felelősség és a humanizmus szószólója. *Prey Penguin*
