A Suitable Boy No Starch Press

Omprakash Valmiki describes his life as an untouchable, or Dalit, in the newly independent India of the 1950s.

"Joothan" refers to scraps of food left on a plate, destined for the garbage or animals. In 1492 Columbus set out across the Atlantic; in 1776 American colonists declared their independence. Between these two events old authorities collapsed—Luther's Reformation divided churches, and various discoveries revealed the ignorance of the ancient Greeks and Romans. A new, empirical worldview had arrived, focusing now on observation, experiment, and mathematical reasoning.
