The Virginia Board of Education's "Student Conduct Policy Guidelines" were first developed in 1994 in response to action

by the 1993 General Assembly requiring the Virginia Board of Education to establish such guidelines. In 2004, the "Guidelines" underwent a major revision in response to requirements of ' 22.1-279.6. of the Code of Virginia, and reflecting numerous changes in state and federal laws and regulations, relevant case law, and emerging best practice principles. The "Virginia Student Conduct Policy Guidelines, 2004," were originally adopted by the Virginia Board of Education on September 22, 2004. The "Guidelines" were updated in 2005, 2006, 2009, and 2013 to incorporate changes in state laws and regulations.
