The four terrorist bombs that exploded in London on 7 July 2005 killed 56 people, including the bombers, and injured more than 700. This narrative summarises what the police, intelligence and security agencies have so far discovered about the bombers and how and why they came to do what they did. The first section details what is known of the bombers' movements on the day, from CCTV and witness accounts. The immediate aftermath is then described, looking at the police and intelligence effort and the Government response until the identification of the four bombers, Shehzad Tanweer, Mohammad Sidique Khan, Hasib Hussain and Jermaine Lindsay. The next section examines why the four men became suicide bombers. The backgrounds of the four men appear largely unexceptional, and there is little to mark them out as particularly vulnerable to radicalisation. Khan, Tanweer and Hussain were apparently well integrated into British society. Lindsay appears to have had more instability at various points in his life, but not exceptionally so. A common factor for Khan, Tanweer and Hussain was the social life around the mosques, youth clubs, gyms and Islamic bookshop in Beeston on the outskirts of Leeds, and group bonding through outdoor activities. Khan was a leading figure here, and Tanweer and Hussain became close to him. Lindsay was the outsider of the group: he converted to Islam in 2000, and it is believed that he was strongly influenced by an extremist preacher, and met Khan when he lived in the Huddersfield area. Their motivation appears to be typical of similar cases: fierce antagonism to perceived injustices by the West against Muslims and a desire for martyrdom. The next section examines visits abroad, especially to Pakistan, and possible contact with Al Qaida figures.

Annexes cover: the evolution of Al Qaida and its associated groups; radicalisation in context; timeline of the evolution of the terrorist threat; timeline of the four individuals. The report concludes that there is still much more to be discovered about how the group were radicalised, how the bombings were planned and executed and whether others were involved.

Saudi Arabia and Bahrain remain key partners for the UK but relations are complicated by the differences between our societies and the pressing need for reform in the Gulf. Historic warm relations between the UK government and the leaders of Saudi Arabia and Bahrain are not mirrored in public opinion in Saudi

Arabia and the UK, and the UK's reputation in Bahrain has also suffered since 2011. The Government must make its public profile and reputation a more central part of its work in the Gulf, consider how it can best support much-needed economic and political reforms, and how it can explain its policies and point to specific achievements when speaking to the public at home and in the Gulf. In Saudi Arabia, the Government must convert its promising steps so far in providing assistance on legal and judicial reform into solid and reportable programmes. In Bahrain, it must work to secure access for NGOs and the UN Special Rapporteur on Torture, and press more strongly for swifter implementation of reforms. Saudi Arabia's role as a key buyer for the UK defence industry is controversial but the report finds little to suggest that ending defence sales from the UK would have any positive effect. The aggressive way in which the Bahraini security forces handled events in 2011 has deeply damaged Bahrain's reputation. The recommendations of the Bahrain Independent Commission of Inquiry (BICI) were sensible and the Bahraini government's failure fully to implement them is inexplicable.

The Committee examines the work of the UK Border Agency (UKBA) on a three monthly basis. Following the abolition of the Agency it will continue to monitor the Home Office UK Visa and Immigration service on a three monthly basis. The Committee found a further backlog of 190,000 cases in the temporary and permanent migration pool that were never revealed to the Committee before. The total figure for the backlog has reached over half a million. The Committee feels it is unacceptable that new backlogs are revealed in Committee evidence sessions. The UK Border Agency had a troubled history. Many of its problems predate the establishment of the Agency. Ministers must now explain how those problems will not outlive its demise. To see a change in the culture in the new organisational structure and management it must be complemented by the ability for a wholesale restructuring of the employees of the organisation. The newly appointed Directors General must have the ability and resources necessary to implement this change. The Home Office should outline exactly how they propose to bring about this change in culture. In evidence the Committee were told the immigration service would never be fixed. This surprised the Committee since reducing immigration is a priority of this Government. What the immigration service needs desperately is stability, the resources necessary to clear the backlogs and a wholesale change in culture Comma Press

This report focuses on how well the UK Border Agency has achieved its objectives of an efficient and effective system for managing migration of workers from outside the European Economic Area. The Agency implemented a Points Based System in 2008, which introduced three main routes for people to come to the UK to work, replacing the previous 39 types of work visa. The System incorporates a route for students to come to the UK to study, which is not considered in this report. The System works by awarding applicants points based on, for example, their skills, qualifications and salary and requiring them to meet a minimum points threshold. The System is objective, transparent and flexible, as the points required can be modified to respond to

changing needs in the UK workforce. However the Agency has not been doing enough to protect resident workers and ensure that migrant workers and sponsoring employers comply with immigration rules. A lack of exit controls makes this more difficult. The Agency estimates there may be 181,000 migrants still in the UK whose permission to remain has expired since December 2008. The Points Based System is rule-based and requires applicants to supply specific documentation to support their applications. Applicants, however, have needed more help to understand the rules and the Agency has introduced a policy of 'evidential flexibility', allowing caseworkers to request additional information in support of applications, to prevent applications being rejected for easily corrected mistakes; however, this is not applied consistently. The Committee welcomes plans to introduce an integrated casework system which should provide the information necessary for dealing with these issues, and expect to see improved performance once the new casework system is fully operational from 2013.
