Michael Sylvester Gardenzio Stallone, born in Manhattan, New York City, New York, U.S., on July 6th, 1946, is an actor, film director, screenwriter, producer, painter and playwright. He's best known for his Hollywood action roles, including boxer Rocky Balboa in the Rocky series (1976-2018), soldier John Rambo in the 5 Rambo movies (1982-2019), and mercenary Barney Ross in the 3 The Expendables films (2010-2014).

Sylvester wrote or co-wrote most of the 14 movies in all 3 franchises, having directed many of them. Stallone's film Rocky was inducted into the National Film Registry, having had its props placed in the Smithsonian Museum. His use of the front entrance to the Philadelphia Museum of Art in the Rocky series, led the area to be nicknamed the Rocky Steps, with Philadelphia having a statue of his Rocky character placed permanently near the museum. It was announced that Sylvester had been voted into the International Boxing Hall of Fame, in the non-participant category, on December 7th, 2010. Stallone was nominated for two Academy Awards for Rocky: Best Original Screenplay and Best Actor during 1977. He became the third man in history to receive these two nominations for the same movie, after Charlie Chaplin and Orson Welles.

Sylvester received positive reviews, as well as his first Golden Globe Award win and a third Academy Award nomination, for reprising the role of Rocky Balboa, in Ryan Coogler's film Creed during 2015.

Rocky Balboa is the Philadelphian icon who took on the world and won. The original "Italian Stallion," the gutsy fighter who rose above the odds to
