 Originally published in 1986, designed for teachers and those concerned with the education of primary and secondary school pupils, Learning Strategies presented a new approach to 'learning to learn'. Its aim was to encourage teachers to start thinking about different approaches to harnessing the potential of young learners. It was also relevant to adult learners, and to those who teach them. Thus, although about learning, the book is also very much about teaching. Learning Strategies presents a critical view of the study skills courses offered in schools at the time, and assesses in non-technical language what contributions could be made to the learning debate by recent developments in cognitive psychology. The traditional curriculum concentrated on 'information' and developing skills in reading, writing, mathematics and specialist subjects, while the more general strategies of how to learn, to solve problems, and to select appropriate methods of working, were too often neglected. Learning to learn involves strategies like planning ahead, monitoring one's performance, checking and self-testing. Strategies like these are taught in

schools, but children do not learn to apply them beyond specific applications in narrowly defined tasks. The book examines the broader notion of learning strategies, and the means by which we can control and regulate our use of skills in learning. It also shows how these ideas can be translated into classroom practice. The final chapter reviews the place of learning strategies in the curriculum.

En el presente libro tiene como objetivo principal servir de ayuda a los profesores de secundaria en la erradicación de los problemas de gramática y ortografía que presentan los alumnos en la educación secundaria obligatoria en la materia de lengua castellana y literatura. Al mismo tiempo, ofrece a los alumnos alternativas didácticas a las presentadas en los libros de texto de lengua en el proceso de enseñanza-aprendizaje de la gramática y la ortografía. Nuestro proyecto presenta la originalidad de haber contado con el alumno para el análisis y creación de las actividades didácticas, así como para el estudio de las principales dificultades que presentan en la gramática y la ortografía. Su colaboración y participación se han convertido en la principal fuente de nuestro trabajo. Sus propuestas nos servirán para solucionar aquellos problemas que con frecuencia encontramos en las producciones escritas de los alumnos, ofreciendo, a la vez, tratamiento didáctico alternativo elaborado por los alumnos de secundaria. En primer lugar, hemos realizado

un estudio comparativo-analítico de las últimas leyes educativas en España (LOGSE y LOE) sobre el currículo de lengua en la educación secundaria obligatoria para posteriormente realizar un seguimiento sobre la adecuación de los libros de texto de lengua a esas leyes educativas. Para ello, se ha investigado las editoriales más utilizadas en Almería y su provincia. Los modelos teóricos aplicados en los libros de texto de lengua desde la perspectiva de la LOGSE y la LOE nos ayudarán a conocer los sistemas de enseñanza-aprendizaje que los libros de texto proponen para la gramática y la ortografía en la secundaria obligatoria. En segundo lugar, se ha investigado cuáles son las principales dificultades que los alumnos presentan en la producción escrita a través de cuestionarios que proponemos a los alumnos de la secundaria obligatoria. Hemos seleccionado tres centros educativos públicos del poniente almeriense para realizar nuestra investigación. La petición realizada a los alumnos de proponer actividades de gramática y ortografía interesantes y creativas, atendiendo a la diversidad, nos ha posibilitado realizar un tratamiento didáctico de las actividades de gramática y ortografía desde el punto de vista del alumno. En tercer lugar, se ha seleccionado un compendio de editoriales por considerar que el libro de texto, previas entrevistas a diversos profesores, es el instrumento seleccionado por la mayoría de los profesores de secundaria. En nuestra investigación partimos de una primera hipótesis y es que la mayoría de las actividades de gramática y ortografía, propuestas por las diferentes editoriales resultan aburridas y de escaso interés entre los alumnos. La mayor parte de los contenidos de lengua y actividades que proponen los profesores vienen derivados de los libros de texto, por lo que nuestra siguiente actuación ha sido analizar las diferentes actividades de enseñanza-aprendizaje de gramática y ortografía que aparecen en las principales editoriales seleccionadas. El proceso de enseñanza-aprendizaje de la gramática y la ortografía en la educación secundaria viene influido y dirigido por la selección del libro de texto de lengua que el departamento de lengua en general y el profesor en particular realice. Este estudio es útil para valorar la importancia que tiene una selección coherente, funcional y creativa de las actividades y contenidos lingüísticos que hagamos. Nuestra segunda hipótesis parte de la idea que la mayoría de las actividades no tienen en cuenta la graduación, la diversidad ni la participación del alumno en el proceso de enseñanza-aprendizaje; para ello, realizaremos un análisis detallado de las principales necesidades educativas que podemos encontrar en el aula y que nos servirán de referencia para incluirlas en nuestras propuestas. El estudio de las actividades de gramática y ortografía en los libros de texto confirman nuestra hipótesis de que su tratamiento no siempre es creativo ni reflexivo en lo que respecta a las actividades propuestas para los alumnos. Nuestro objetivo es conocer cuáles son las preferencias de los alumnos en el diseño de las actividades de gramática y ortografía, así como solicitar la colaboración y participación en la creación de las actividades didácticas que serán aplicadas posteriormente en el aula. Por último, nuestra investigación propone un tratamiento didáctico de las actividades de enseñanza-aprendizaje de la gramática y la ortografía realizada por los alumnos de secundaria de los tres centros educativos seleccionados. También ayudará a resolver las principales dificultades que se analizaron al principio de nuestra investigación con la aplicación de nuestras propuestas. Las posibilidades de realizar otras investigaciones pueden servir de ayuda complementaria a nuestro estudio, por lo que proponemos otras líneas futuras de actuación que pueden desarrollar las propuestas realizadas.

Frege's Theorem collects eleven essays by Richard G Heck, Jr, one of the world's leading authorities on Frege's philosophy. The Theorem is the central contribution of Gottlob Frege's formal work on arithmetic. It tells us that the axioms of arithmetic can be derived, purely logically, from a single principle: the number of these things is the same as the number of those things just in case these can be matched up one-to-one with those. But that principle seems so utterly fundamental to thought about number that it might almost count as a definition of number. If so, Frege's Theorem shows that arithmetic follows, purely logically, from a near definition. As Crispin Wright was the first to make clear, that means that Frege's logicism, long thought dead, might yet be viable. Heck probes the philosophical significance of the Theorem, using it to launch and then guide a wide-ranging exploration of historical, philosophical, and technical issues in the philosophy of mathematics and logic, and of their connections with metaphysics, epistemology, the philosophy of language and mind, and even developmental psychology. The book begins with an overview that introduces the Theorem and the issues surrounding it, and explores how the essays that follow contribute to our understanding of those issues. There are also new postscripts to five of the essays, which discuss changes of mind, respond to published criticisms, and advance the discussion yet further.

Literally hundreds of languages world-wide have experienced direct or indirect Hispanisation during the heyday of the Spanish colonial empire. The number of languages which continue to borrow from Spanish on a daily basis is considerable especially in Latin America. This volume gives the reader a better idea of the range of contact constellations in which Spanish functions as the donor language. Moreover, the contributions to this collection of articles demonstrate that it is not only possible to compare the contact-induced processes in the (Hispanised) languages of Austronesia and the Americas. It is emphasized that one can draw far-reaching conclusions from the presented borrowing facts for the theory of language contact in general. The volume is divided into two sections according to geographical principles: section I is devoted to contacts of Spanish in Latin America. Two contributions look at the Hispanisation of varieties of Nahuatl (Classical Nahuatl studied by Anne Jensen and modern varieties studied by José Antonio Flores Farfán). Martina Schrader-Kniffki discusses Spanish-Zapotec contacts and their relations to language mixing and purism. Luciano Giannelli and Raoul Zamponi address the issue of Hispanisms in Kuna, a language from Panama. For South America, Jorge Gómez-Rendón discusses whether or not there are constraints on lexical borrowing from Spanish into Imbabura Quichua. Suzanne Dikker studies the intertwined language Media Lengua in her attempt at redefining the notion of relexification. Section II focuses on the impact of Spanish on the languages of Austronesia and South-East Asia. Steven Roger Fischer shows that the heavy Hispanisation of Rapanui is currently being reverted. Steve Pagel compares Hispanisation processes and their results in the Mariana Islands and on Rapa Nui. The second comparative study is by Patrick O. Steinkrüger who reviews a variety of Philippinian languages and their degrees of Hispanisation. The attitudes of native speakers of Chamorro as to Hispanisms is the topic of the study by Rosa Salas Palomo and Thomas Stolz. The volume is especially interesting for students of language contact. But also scholars with a background in Romance linguistics or Hispanic philology will find the assembled articles very useful, as well as Austronesianists and Amerindianists.

This book tries to present in brief compass a metaphysical system, matured (as is hoped) over many years. By metaphysics is understood an account of the fundamental categories of being, such notions as property, relation, causality. These notions are more abstract than the results of scientific inquiry, and are controversial among scientists as well as among philosophers. The book sprang from lectures given to graduate students, and has deliberately been kept at an informal level. It includes some explanations not required in a book for professional philosophers. The argument is developed in sixteen short chapters. It is argued that the world is a world of states of affairs, involving universals and particulars. The notion of finding suitable truthmakers for truths grows in importance as the book proceeds.
