Another way to study the energy problem, because of its political and social consequences, is to resolve it into geographical areas. As producer, consumer, or both, each wants to ensure an energy development program which will work to the maximum benefit of its citizens. These competing and conflicting goals call for a study which encompasses the whole world. Again, complexity is piled upon complexity. If the problem is not yet sufficiently complex, there is an
