Long before Batman, Flash Gordon, or the Lone Ranger were the stars of their own TV shows, they had dedicated audiences watching their adventures each week. The difference was that this action took place on the big screen, in short adventure serials whose exciting cliffhangers compelled the young audience to return to the theater every seven days. *Matinee Melodrama* is the

first book about the adventure serial as a distinct artform, one that uniquely encouraged audience participation and imaginative play.
