According to agency officials and guidance posted on State's

public website, applicants can apply for a U.S. passport in one of three ways: in person at an acceptance facility, by mail (for renewal applications), or at a passport facility that offers acceptance services (typically expedited applications). Applicants submit documents, such as a birth certificate or driver's license, to passport acceptance agents to provide evidence of citizenship, or noncitizen nationality, and proof of identity. The acceptance agents are to watch the applicant sign the application, review submitted documents for completeness, and check for application inconsistencies. For example, acceptance agents are to assess whether photographs and descriptions in the identification documents match the applicant.

The passport is one of the most widespread documents in worldwide use and yet, paradoxically, it has no basis in law: one state cannot demand another to do something - give access - simply by issuing a document. Yet, by insisting on the requirement of holding a passport the state has provided itself with a neat self-financing, data collection and surveillance system. He is a dangerous criminal who soon after meeting Kathleen finds himself behind bars as a result of his participation in a brawl at a local racecourse. Kathleen is in a terrible predicament. A pregnant, unmarried woman in the Republic of Ireland during the 1940's represented an affront to the all-powerful catholic church. State sponsored and church run institutions were set up to cater for 'fallen women' who were seen as a moral threat to Irish society. Alone and scared, Kathleen is forced to take measures to ensure that she and her child are not incarcerated in one of these awful places.

U.S. Passport Renewal Application for Eligible Individuals, Form DS-82 (2010)

In FY 2007, the U.S. Mission in Mexico processed 1.5 million of the 8 million nonimmigrant visas (NIV) that the Dept. of State handled worldwide. This workload is expected to increase dramatically in the coming years as millions of NIV Border Crossing Cards issued in Mexico during FY 1998 to 2002 expire and need to be renewed. Consulates will also face increased workloads which will require U.S. citizens to carry passports, or other approved documentation, when traveling between the U.S. and Mexico, including by land. This report reviews State's: (1) estimates of the workload for consulates in Mexico through 2012; and (2) efforts to help ensure consulates keep pace with expected workload increases.
