 “The Prophecies of A Father” is a remarkable piece of literary work. The writer, His Excellency Ambassador Eddie M. Turay is very sincere and passionate in the presentation of his facts. The facts relate to the culture, traditions, customs and party politics of his country. The writer’s sincerity and passion revolves around the traditional

beliefs and faith of his benevolent father in his ancestral spirits, late Paramount Chief Kande Turay of Sanda Chiefdom. He reveals that the late man was an animist who despite neither believed nor practiced Christianity and Islam, yet he gave him the freedom and support to become a practicing Christian. religions (Christianity and Islam) but he was a great admirer of the Whiteman's education. Paramount Chieftaincy is one of the oldest and respectable political institutions in this part of the African Continent. The writer has thrown enlightening lights on the way it works in the Sanda

Chieftdom, Northern Sierra Leone. One more amazing revelation of the book is the prophecies of the writer's father.
