How do you know what you know is true? During the blizzard of 1978, a woman is discovered face down at the edge of her Delaware estate, a boxer, half-dead, by her side. Nearby, in a deep ravine,

a CIA officer lies buried under two feet of snow. Their secret meeting--sabotaged.
