Some of the revised papers presented in this book originate from a workshop held at the European University Institute of Florence, Italy, in December 2006. The Air Force currently funds projects chartered with studying and developing e-Procurement systems. Through review and analysis of various e- Procurement projects, factors attributing to successful

implementation of e- Procurement systems will be deduced and provided as a useful guide for federal agencies initiating e-Procurement projects.
