This book is about the results of analyzing the Quran with Machine Learning using Natural Language Processing (NLP). This was

performed using software developed by Hourglass Software LLC and leverages Amazon AWS Comprehend service (NLP). Not all Surahs are analyzed, however. Thus, the entire of the Quran is not covered, but we can see the results of analysis of the ones that are. The software performs two primary functions; first, it determines the sentiment of the text (positive sentiment, negative sentiment, or

neutral sentiment). Second, it extracts the top two key phrases of the text (based on Machine Learning confidence score). You will see that each Surah analyzed will show these results. Additionally, there is brief commentary of the top two extracted phrases by providing the context. The analysis is done on the original Arabic text. However, it was also performed on the English translation

used. The translations are by Ahmed Ali, Amatul Rahman Omar, Daryabadi, Faridul Haque, Hamid S. Aziz, Maulana Mohammad Ali, Pickthall, Sarware, Shakir, and Yusuf Ali. The structure of each analysis is first the Surah in Arabic, then the English translation and then details of the analysis. This includes the sentiment, then the top two phrase extraction, and then brief commentary

of the extractions. The top extractions are the exact word/s in Arabic, then the English corresponding translation. The sentiment analysis is based on the entire Surah, and the top two extractions are what Machine Learning identifies are the most important or key identifications in the text, including being based on the context and other algorithms used by

The effects of this affliction can be seen in many people, and this problem is the cause of every disaster and adversity. *The Meaning of the Holy Quran* Iblīs, the character in the Qur'an who refuses God's command to bow to Adam and is punished by eviction from heaven, is commonly depicted as a fiendish character no

different from Satan. However, some Sufi stories describe Iblīs as the ultimate monotheist, a lover of God, but tragically rejected. This volume seeks the origins of this alternative Iblīs within the Qur'an itself, by looking at each of the seven Qur'anic versions of the Iblīs story as a unique rendering of the basic narrative.
