In 1933, the eighteen

year old Patrick Leigh Fermor set out in a pair of hobnailed boots to chance and charm his way across Europe, like a tramp, a pilgrim or a wandering scholar . The books he later wrote about this walk, *A Time of Gifts*, *Between the Woods and the Water*, and the posthumous *The Broken Road* are a half-remembered, half-reimagined journey through cultures now extinct, landscapes irrevocably altered by the traumas of the twentieth century. Aged eighteen, Nick Hunt read *A Time of Gifts* and dreamed of following in Fermor's footsteps. In 2011 he began his own great trudge - on foot all the way to Istanbul.
