Alexios, elated at the idea of showing off his

qualities as a military commander, will discover that intrigue, power games and war always have a price to pay, and his youthful illusions will face a harsh reality. Soon after his arrival he begins to understand the bitterness of the local reality and concludes that the defeat of Karman is not enough to ensure peace, he will decide to rebel against his uncle and take the throne for himself, propelling him and his allies to an uncertain future.

The nuclear structure and models of the nucleus are also considered. The book concludes with an analysis of the Brueckner-Bethe-Goldstone theory of nuclear matter. This book will be of interest to physicists.
