Multivariate Statistics Definition Statistics that encompass the simultaneous observation and analysis of more than one statistical variable with a focus on assessing the strength and identifying patterns of association between or among the variables.

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Multivariate Statistics Often in experimental design, multiple variables are related in such a way that by analyzing them simultaneously additional information, and often times essentially information, can be gathered that would be missed if each variable was examined individually (as is the case in univariate analyses).

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The multivariate analysis procedures are used to investigate relationships among variables without designating some as independent and others as dependent.
