The ISM Code has been mandatory for almost every commercial vessel in the world for more than a decade and nearly two decades for high risk vessels, yet there is very little case law in this area. Consequently, there remains a great deal of confusion about the potential legal and insurance implications of the Code. This third edition represents a major re-write and addresses significant amendments that were made to the ISM Code on 1st July 2010 and 1st January 2015. This book provides practitioners with a practical overview of, and much needed guidance on, the potential implications of failing to implement the requirements of the Code. It will be hugely valuable to DPAs, managers of ship operating companies,

ship masters, maritime lawyers and insurance claims staff.

Practical Pack

This study examines the overall effectivity in implementing and communicating the ISM Code to its seafarers through its merchant vessels. Survey questionnaires were used to gather the data while the technique of stratified random sampling using Slovin's formula was used to choose the respondents. The respondents of the research were stratified based on the manning agent they are currently employed. The researcher employed the use of Runs test or Wald Wolfowitz, a non-parametric statistical test in checking the hypothesis. The researcher formulated survey questions which were focused mainly on the views of the seafarers and their understanding of the ISM Code in implementing the ISM Code's purpose. The findings showed that seafarers are knowledgeable in ISM Code and that compliance to it is very well implemented onboard. Moreover, the results show that the merchant vessels comply with the regulations set forth in the ISM Code through the trainings given to the seafarers, emergency drills and

documentation, audit, and evaluation of prevention activities. However, the results of the audits which could greatly help improve the compliance and awareness of the seafarers are not often discussed nor informed to them. The result of the study helps structure a good grounding on how the ISM Code safeguards the life of the passengers. It also instills awareness to the society on the benefits of the shipping industry to the environment and its personnel. Furthermore, the result abets in determining whether the implementation process and job knowledge of the personnel on board is acceptable to the

standards of the ISM Code.
