The highly mutating virus COVID 19 has practically brought the world to its knees, and we must assume it was 'released from the lab' in Wuhan, China. Dr Francis Boyle, an expert in bio-warfare, recently said: 'the Coronavirus that we are dealing with here is an offensive biological warfare weapon. There have been previous reports of problems with the Wuhan Institute of Virology and 'things' leaking out of it.' The Salisbury Poisonings series on television during the COVID 19 lockdown acquainted a broad global audience the horrendous properties of Novichok and its terrible effects on people who come into contact with it. Do not own any responsibility. Dismiss, denigrate, destroy if necessary, those who challenge the status quo. This is my story and that of others who dispute the claim that 'Lyme Disease does not exist in Australia'. Alongside the history of Lyme will be the history of the strategies used against those patients and researchers who are fighting to claw back the right to decent medical care. Indeed, that is not such a big ask. Then why is it? 'In the fullness of time, the mainstream handling of chronic Lyme disease will be viewed as one of the most shameful episodes in the history of medicine because elements of the government and virtually the entire insurance industry have colluded to deny the disease.'
