The definitive end of her cinematic career came under Nasser on the eve of the 1956 Suez War. Egyptians have long told their

national story through interpretations of Murad's life, intertwining the individual and Egyptian state and society to better understand Egyptian identity. As Unknown Past recounts, there's no life better than Murad's to reflect the tumultuous changes experienced over the dramatic decades of the mid-twentieth century.
