Many states will randomly select questions from the bank in order to produce an individual exam thus preventing future test takers from knowing all the answers. The 500 questions within this publication are not the questions from the actual state examinations. In fact, no one really knows what is in a state's bank of questions, so don't let anyone fool you by saying, "that's not on the exam" or "that question will be there for sure." While we don't know any specific questions or answers, we do know the content topics and the "types" of questions that you will likely see.
