In addition to the musical sources and sketches, other documents in this volume, such as a preliminary outline of the work in the hand of the painter, Pablo Picasso (*Musée Picasso*) and a more detailed scenario written out by the choreographer, Leonide Massine (Basel), will help scholars to understand the nature of the collaboration among these luminaries [the composer Igor

Stravinsky (1882-1971), the Spanish painter Pablo Picasso (1881-1973), the Russian choreographer Léonide Massine (1895-1979), and the Russian impresario Sergei Diaghilev (1872-1929)] that resulted in this astonishing dramatic work for dance and song.
